

**Subject: Small Tripline Design Change** 

## Background

Triplines failing immediately below the bullet assembly has been a recurring issue on small Bambi Buckets. Several design changes have reduced the number of occurrences, but the issue has persisted on small buckets. The root cause on small buckets is believed to be the cable flexing as the bullet hits the pulley. A new design allows the cable to pivot freely immediately after the bullet to eliminate this issue.

The new designs 013055 and 013056 will replace 005335 and 005332 respectively. The new design is a direct replacement, and does not require any additional modification.



## Recommendations

New triplines made by SEI will use the new design. Customers with the old design should continue to use those triplines if they have not encountered problems with them.
