

Onion Tank



In emergencies, and on remote sites, reliable access to potable drinking water is imperative. Militaries, emergency relief agencies, and various industry organizations rely on the Onion Tank for these functions across the globe. This open-top tank is approved for potable water. It is available in a catalogue of sizes, each constructed of heavy-duty urethane-coated fabric. It comes complete with a top cover, which prevents evaporation and contamination. The Onion Tank is fully collapsible, making it easy to transport and store.

Onion Tank Features

- The unique flotation collar requires no inflation and is also capable of supporting a hose for top filling;
- The fitted top cover is firmly held in place by shock cord straps or a zipper to minimize contamination, while still aiding quick installation and easy access for inspection;
- Handles on the outside of the tank allow for easy lifting, while a handle on the inside of the tank allows it to be turned inside-out for easy cleaning;
- Two 2" fill/drain ports, 180° apart, provide the capability to discharge liquid quickly from either side of the tank; and
- Flange and abrasion covers provide protection for the drain ports.



Design Features

- No assembly required; the self-supporting design allows for quick set-up and tear-down;
- Completely collapsible; the Onion Tank can be easily folded, taking up minimal storage space; and
- Deployment anywhere; the low profile of the Onion Tank provides stability on slopes up to 12.5 degrees, allowing deployment with minimal site preparation.

Aqua-Shield 30 oz. NSF Standard 61 (approved for potable water storage) 32 oz. Mil-Spec (Mil-T-53029C).

Chem-Shield 30 oz. Chemical-resistant fabric for grey or black water storage.
